This is the 25th anniversary year of the Catholic Education Foundation of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. Focused on a dedicated mission, led by a committed Board of Trustees and a Board of Regents, and administered by a compassionate staff,

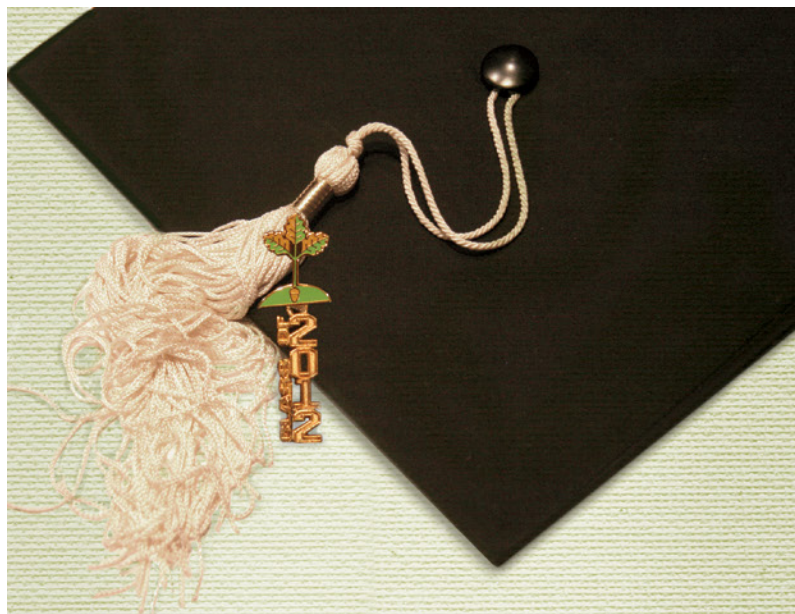
